Our in-house laboratory allows same day results on many blood and urine tests. Our radiology department is equipped to take full body x-rays and dental x-rays. By using digital technology, we have immediate access to x-rays, which provides rapid feed back on your pet's health.





WELLNESS CARE

At each visit, your pet will be thoroughly examined by a veterinarian, to help determine whether he/she is healthy enough



to receive vaccinations, and to reveal underlying medical problems early in the course of disease. The doctor will tailor a vaccine and wellness protocol that meets your pet's needs, and will answer questions you have about maintaining a healthy lifestyle for your pet.

LASER SURGERY

We utilize a CO₂ laser for many surgical procedures. The laser seals nerve endings and small blood vessels as it cuts. For your pet, this means less post-operative pain and bleeding. Your pet typically will return to normal activity more quickly after surgery.

DENTAL CARE

Oak Knoll is able to provide comprehensive dental services for your pet, as well as important information regarding at-home dental maintenance. Routine dental prophylaxis includes scaling, polishing and applying fluoride and a sealant to your pet's teeth while he or she is under anesthesia. At that point, we will determine if there is a need for dental x-rays, we will apply an antibiotic gel to the gumline to help prevent invasion by bacteria and do any necessary tooth extractions.
